The celebrations for **St Swithun's Weekend** begin on Thursday 12 July with a performance of 'Much Ado about Nothing' in Hempsted Village Hall Garden at 7.30pm. On Saturday 14 July, church and school come together to put on a traditional village fete 12noon-3pm as together we mark the commemoration of the end of the World War 1 and commit to peace and reconciliation in Gloucester. The opening ceremony attended by the Mayor of Gloucester will take place at 12noon by the War Memorial in the churchyard. There will be art and flower displays in church, teas in the Lysons Hall, stalls (including FoSS and Messy Church) and traditional games on the school playing field. Bring a deckchair! On Sunday 15 July we have a United Parish Eucharist at 10am and Choral Evensong at 6pm. Both services are followed by drinks and the church will be open all day to view the flowers and children's art work.
